Penn High School Chinese Academy (PHSCA) is inviting 10 experienced Chinese teachers to participate in a workshop on Chinese Culture, including topics of Chinese philosophy, fine arts, religion, film and children's literature. After the workshop, participants will observe the Penn High School Chinese Academy for one week, participating in course preparation, teaching individual tutorial sections, and developing teaching materials.

- Each grantee will participate in the July 5th - 9th workshop on Chinese culture.
- Each will observe the PHSCA classroom during a self-selected week, interacting with PHSCA students and instructors
- Each will receive Act 48 credit
- Each will receive \$500 for the completion of the one-week workshop, one-week observation, as well as submitting a theme-based curriculum plan for Level I, Level II or AP Chinese.
