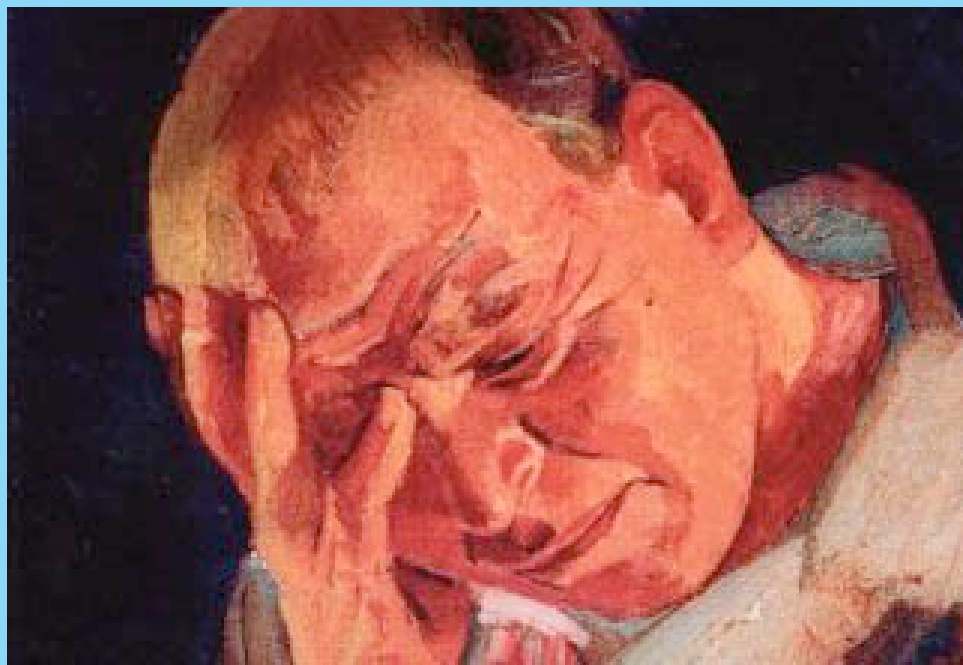


Sunshine, Blossoms and Blood ***H.N. Bialik in His Time:*** ***A Literary Biography***

(January 9, 1873–July 4, 1934), is considered
one of the first, and certainly the most influen-
tial, of modern Hebrew poets, and is widely
recognized as Israel's National Poet.

Columbia University, specializing in the teaching of
Languages and Literatures. She lectures regularly on
Hebrew, Yiddish, and French Literature, in the United
States, Canada, and Eastern Europe.
